## Marine Education Begins in Kindergarten

The TeachBlue conference – “Marine education begins in kindergarten” took place as a structured one-day event, bringing together educators to explore how marine awareness can be introduced from early childhood.

The programme combined presentations on Erasmus+ project origins, research findings, and curriculum results with practical demonstrations (games, multimedia tools, 360° videos) and teachers’ real-life experiences, alongside interactive group activities and reflections to support the integration of marine education into kindergarten practice.

# TeachBlue Event – Marine Education and Innovation in Practice

The TeachBlue event took place as an afternoon session, bringing together educators, researchers, and experts to present the Erasmus+ TeachBlue project and its contribution to marine education. The programme included presentations on sustainable management of marine resources, the innovative TeachBlue educational toolkit, and its application through games and teacher training.

The event also highlighted pilot implementations in primary education and shared teachers' experiences, followed by a discussion and a hands-on workshop, allowing participants to actively engage with the tools and methodologies. Overall, the event focused on strengthening educators' skills and promoting practical approaches to integrating marine awareness into education



# Awareness Campaign in Cyprus

## Erasmus Day

The Erasmus Festival took place on 18 October in Paphos, bringing together schools, universities, and NGOs to celebrate Erasmus+ initiatives. The event included exhibition stands, a live radio broadcast, a cultural programme, and activities for children. CMMI participated by presenting and promoting the TeachBlue Toolkit through interactive engagement with participants. The team directly reached young students and their families, raising awareness and fostering interest in marine-related topics.

## Hooked on Family fishing

The “Hooked on Family Fishing” event took place on Saturday, 25 October at the Alaminos Fishing Shelter in Cyprus, in collaboration with the American Academy of Larnaca. The event combined educational presentations on marine life, hands-on fishing training, and interactive activities. CMMI participated by presenting and promoting the TeachBlue Toolkit through interactive engagement with participants. The event provided an opportunity for the team to directly reach educators and students, raising awareness on marine protection and education.
