Successful Completion of the TeachBlue Training Workshop 3–7 September 2025 – Larnaca, Cyprus

The TeachBlue training workshop was successfully completed in Larnaca from the 3-7 September 2025. The workshop focused on **professional development in Ocean Literacy for Early Childhood Education**, bringing together enthusiastic educators from across Europe (Poland, Greece, Portugal and Cyprus). This five-day professional training workshop marked an important milestone of the Erasmus+ TeachBlue project, aimed at empowering early childhood educators to integrate ocean literacy through developmentally appropriate and creative approaches. The TeachBlue Educational Toolkit, supports global sustainability efforts by aligning with:

- UNESCO's Ocean Literacy Framework
- UN Sustainable Development Goal 14: Life Below Water
- The UN Decade of Ocean Science for Sustainable Development (2021–2030)



Designed for children aged **4-8 years**, the toolkit transforms ocean literacy concepts into accessible and inspiring learning experiences, laying the foundations for a lifelong commitment to ocean stewardship and connections by the share vision of **cultivating environmental awareness and sustainability** from the earliest stages of learning.
